



## A Biblical Worldview — 7 Key Questions To Ask

Every day, set aside 30 minutes to sit down together as a family to do the following:

### 1. Reading

- Spend 10 minutes reading **one of the following passages** together.
- Divide it among your family so that everyone gets a chance to read.

#### ***Who Is God?***

*(Isa 45:18-19; Jer 32:17; Ps 103:19; Gen 17:1; Matt 19:26; 1 Hn 3:20; John 21:17; Ps 36:9; Ps 104:27-30)*

#### ***Who Am I?***

*(Gen 1:26-27; Ps 139:15-16; Isa 44:24)*

#### ***What Is The Role Of My Parents And Family?***

*(Prov 22:6; Eph 6:4; 2 Tim 1:5; Luke 15:20; Col 3:21; Prov 13:24; Eph 6:1-3; Col 3:20; Prov 1:8; Ps 78:5-7; Deut 6:5-7)*

#### ***What Is The Role Of My Friends?***

*(Prov 13:20; Prov 27:17; Ecc 4:9-12; 1 Cor 15:33; Jam 4:4; 2 Tim 4:14-16)*

#### ***What Is Right And Wrong (And Can I Really Know)?***

*(Ps 31:5; Deut 32:4; Ps 19:7-11; John 17:17; John 1:14; John 12:35-36)*

#### ***What Is The Meaning Of History (Where Is All This Going)?***

*(Ps 103:19; Ps 135:6; Isa 46:9-11; Rom 8:28; Eph 1:11)*

#### ***What Is The Purpose Of My Life (Why Am I Here)?***

*(Rev 4:11; Isa 43:7; Ps 16:11)*

- After reading, ask the following questions:
  - **Consider...**What stands out to you from this text?
  - **He is...**What do we learn about God?
  - **We are...**What do we learn about people?
  - **I will...**What has the Holy Spirit revealed to you in this passage, and how will you obey it in your life this week?
  - **You can...**Who do you know who needs to hear this?

### 2. Praying

- Spend 10 minutes praying together.
- Find a quiet space that your family can gather together. Adults, lead the prayer time and invite your students to join in.
- Ask the questions, “*who do we need to pray for?*”; “*what needs are we aware of within our family, friend, and neighbor circles?*”

### 3. Journaling

- Spend 10 minutes journaling together.
- Have paper and something to write with ready.
- Write down what stood out to you from the text you read as a family.
- Write down what you can remember from prayer time. (Thoughts about specific people, places, or events that were prayed for, as well as any personal thoughts.)

### 4. Repeat Daily
